

## How to swap your ITT JEC motor for the new ITT Argonaut motor





The following procedure describes how to replace the motor on a JEC pump with the new AV pump motor. This procedure assumes that the JEC pump wet-end (tank) is in full working condition.




- 1) Isolate power supply to the pump.
- 2) Open terminal box and disconnect live, neutral and earth connections (see photo 1).
- 3) Drain the water from the system as best as possible.



4) Unbolt the motor mountings that fix the pump to the floor (see photo 2). Keep bolts safe!



5) Remove the four bolts that connect the wet-end of the pump to the bracket (see photo 3). Keep bolts safe!

6) Remove the JEC motor including bracket (see photo 4).



7) Unscrew 4 bolts that bolt together tank and motor on new AV pump (see photo 5).



8) Remove motor from AV pump (see photo 6).



- 9) Mate the new motor to the existing tank. Refit the four bolts from the old pump to secure the motor to the tank (see photo 7).
- 10) Bolt the motor to the floor using the existing bolts.



11) Connect power cable to terminal box (see photo 8).

- 12) Important! With 3-phase motors, before refilling tank with water, ensure that the pump is running in the right direction (clockwise, when looking at rear of pump).
- 13) Switch on power supply.
- 14) Commission pump as described in instruction manual.
